Plant breeding in Tasmania is very focused on persistent dryland species, mostly perennials. Species which tolerate high temperatures and very dry summers.

New Zealand plant breeders have focused on high production, late flowering ryegrass/white clover species suitable for the Manawatu, Southland or irrigated Canterbury.

Thanks to our Tasmanian connection, Kiwi Seed now have the greatest selection of dryland pasture species in New Zealand and more to come.
