What to plant in August:

• **Vegetables:** Sow seeds indoors or under cover for tomatoes, capsicums, and zucchini. Direct sow beetroot, broccoli, cauliflower, cabbage, chives, coriander, dill, parsley, celery, leeks, lettuce, pak choi, rocket, and spring onions. Plant garlic and broad beans.

• **Fruit:** Plant new citrus trees and strawberry plants.

• **Flowers:** Plant summer-flowering bulbs. Plant bee-attracting flowers like calendulas, poppies, bergamots, and lavenders. Consider planting camellias, azaleas, and hebes. Also, pansies, daphne, and alyssum will add color to your garden, according to Palmers.

**Herbs:** Maintain your herb garden by trimming thyme, bay, parsley, and rosemary.

Other tasks:

- Prune hydrangeas, cutting back to two fat buds.
- Prepare vegetable and flower gardens for spring planting.
- Consider laying a plank over carrot rows to help retain moisture and aid germination.
- Stake broad beans to protect them from spring winds.

Start preparing your soil for spring planting.  
Important Considerations:

- August is still cold and wet, so protect your plants from frost and excessive moisture.
- Pay attention to the specific needs of your plants, such as sun exposure and drainage.
- Ensure adequate space for your plants to grow and avoid overcrowding.

Keep an eye out for pests and diseases.


