Out in the garden



Everyone likes to keep cut flowers around as long as possible, and there are several good methods. One way is to mix 2 tablespoons apple cider vinegar and 2 tablespoons sugar with the vase water before adding the flowers. Be sure to change the water (with more vinegar and sugar, of course) every few days to enhance your flowers' longevity.

Weeding, feeding, mulching and irrigating are the main garden tasks this time of the year. Lightly prune spelled rose flowers to encourage new blooms.

Re-sow some more lettuces, carrots, beans for a continuous food supply and don't forget to cover your berry fruit to protect them from hungry birds, now that they are starting to ripen.



Problems with aphids, thrips, ants, mites, earwigs, snails and slugs on lettuces and other veggies, try Diatomaceous Earth (DE Bug). This is a food grade mineral based pesticide which does not harm earthworms.

DE can also be used as a feed supplement for livestock and farm animals. Dust it on top of grain in storage and protect your feed from getting infested with Indian meal moth and other weevils.
