Sow seeds of winter vegetables like cabbage, cauliflower, broccoli, beetroot, winter lettuce, brussel sprouts, spinach, carrots, leeks and silverbeet. We have a great range of Mr Fothergills seeds as well as a few Yates Seeds left.

Sow greencrops – phacelia, lupin, buckwheat, red clover or mustard to give your soil a rest between crops, to provide a living mulch for autumn plantings.

Applying mulch around the base of your plants can conserve up to 70% moisture in the soil and also suppresses weed growth. Use Daltons Mulch & Grow or Yates Hauraki Gold Peat Moss.

Keep lawn weeds under control this month so you can sow grass seed in the autumn.

Use Grassmate or Turfix to eliminate broadleaf weeds.



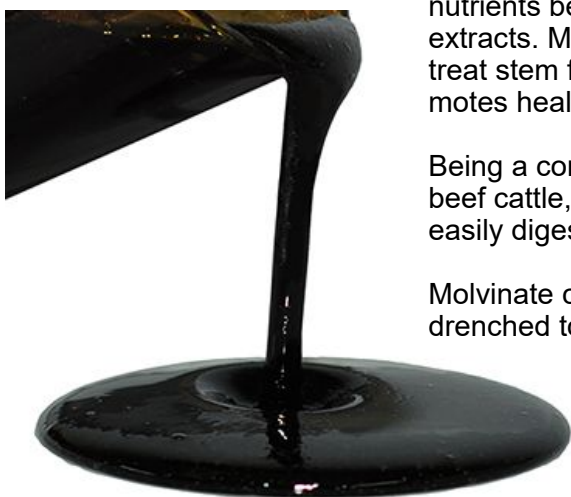
