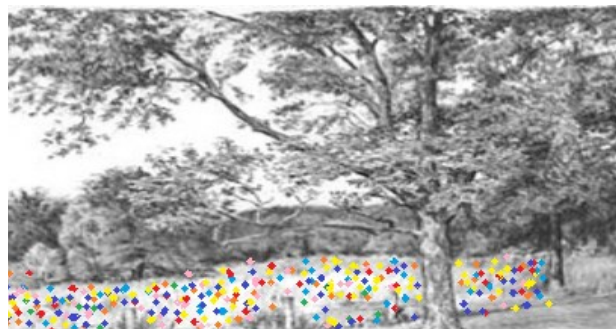

Pasture renovation

There is still time to renovate your pasture and sow seeds this month, especially if sowing has been delayed due to the wet spring.

In the Garden



The weather is warming up and now is a good time to plant out your seedlings.

November is the time to sow basil, beetroot, beans, broccoli, cabbage, capsicum, carrot, celery, chilli, coriander, courgette, cucumber, eggplant, leek, lettuce, mesclun, parsley, parsnip, pumpkin and squash, radish, rocket, silverbeet, spinach, spring onions, sweetcorn, tomatoes. Check out our Mr Fothergills seed stand in store for all of your vege seeds.

Feed your vegetables with Kiwi Seed General Garden Fertiliser.

Now is a good time to plant your main crop seed potatoes. We still have a small range in store. Remember to feed them once a month with Potato Fertiliser until harvest.

Protect apples and pears from codling moth by hanging traps in the branches of the trees
