Before considering a new feed regime for your horse in spring...

*Monitor body condition. Have they gained or lost weight over winter?
*Do they have access to plenty of forage or do they need to be kept off spring grass?

Does fibre need to be supplemented?

*Do they require less concentrates or something that is low starch/sugar?

*Are they getting the minerals and vitamins they require.

WHEN SHOULD I WEAN MY LAMB??

You can consider weaning your lamb at around 10—12 weeks of age.

However, before you start to wean your lamb, they should be at least 3 times their birth weight (no less than 10kg), and be eating grass and drinking water themselves.

At weaning, milk should be gradually reduced over a few weeks, and then stopped altogether. A slow weaning is less stressful on the lamb.

Out in the garden

October is the time for planting new roses.
Use Daltons Premium Compost and a good slow release
Fertiliser such as Nitrophoska when planting.

Feed existing Roses by sprinkling a few handfuls of Daltons Premium Compost around the base of the plant and Kiwi Seed Rose Fertiliser.

Protect Roses from Insects and Disease by spraying every two weeks with Yates Super Shield.

Remember not to spray blooms to protect bees that may visit.

Labour weekend is the time to plant your Sweetcorn seeds directly into your garden. We have plenty of Honey and Pearl Sweetcorn Seed available in store.

Grow your corn in blocks or short rows rather than one or two long rows as this will help with pollination. Sow corn seeds in pairs, 25 mm deep, in moist well-drained soil direct where they are to grow. No further watering is needed until seedlings appear. The weaker of the two seedlings can be thinned out when they reach around 15 cm tall.

Corn is a gross feeding plant and will benefit from regular feeding with a nitrogen rich fertilizer.

Soak the roots of your vegetable seedings in a solution of Maxicrop Seaweed Extract before planting.

This will give them a boost and ensure they become strong, healthy plants.

Sow eggplant, lettuce, cucumber, courgettes, capsicum, pumpkin and cauliflower directly into the ground.

Protect new seedlings from slugs and snails with No Pest Slugoff Lentils. They are a long lasting option. Feed with Maxicrop Seaweed Extract to grow strong plants.

Its not too late to sow lawn seed!

Ensure that the seed is raked into the soil or covered with a light dressing of Daltons Lawn soil for protection. Keep seed watered daily, but be careful not to over water so that water forms puddles and washes seed away.
